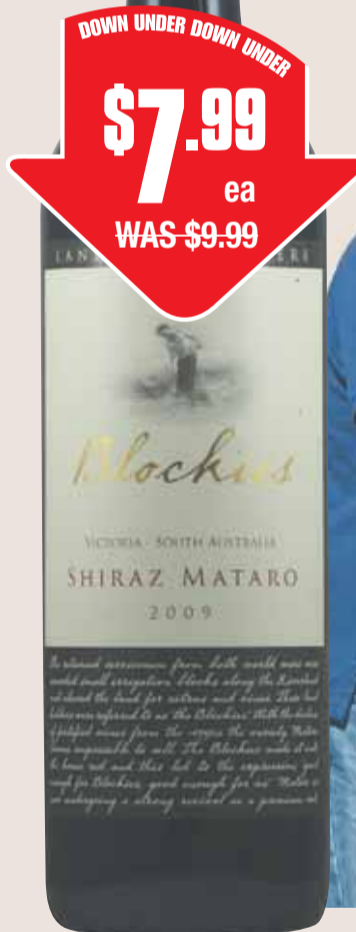


Mark Warren - Winemaker Cape Geographe

Cape Geographe 'White Classic' Classic Dry White Margaret River 2010
 The bloke who makes the Cape Geographe wines, we have to say is a champion. Mark Warren is the Chief Winemaker at Happs winery in Margaret River and here are some recent accolades: Happs Winery-Winners of the 2010 Perth Royal Wine Show Trophies for Most Successful WA Exhibitor (Processing under 300 tonnes) and Most Successful WA Exhibitor Overall, while at the recent Margaret River Show, Mark also picked up a bag of gold medals-six if our memory is correct. If that is not enough he produces fantastic top value wines under the Cape Geographe label. The Classic Dry White Style was invented years ago to allow winemakers to make up a batch of all the odds and sods left in the winery. Yet not only is this wine 100% Margaret River but it is made from the two premium varieties sauvignon blanc and semillon. The wine offers sensational value for money.

 This is the second of the Blockies releases we have selected and a natural for our Best Value Und'r series. The Blockies is a gorgeous, super thick, warm, inviting red blend that delivers enormous punch for a modest price. Again we rate it the best Down Under discovery this month and in any masked tasting The Blockies would pass muster against +\$15 reds. So this is a superdiscovery and a must for the shopping basket. We think the mataro makes the difference and were told its from low cropping vines in the Barossa Valley. The shiraz base is from Swan Hill, Victoria. The final blending was done in the Barossa Valley. The aim at all times was to make a serious wine at a great value price point, which is really the buying idea which we use at Down Under Cellars. As they say about this wine; 'good enough for Blockies, good enough for us'. In case you are wondering we discovered that the 'Blockies' is a reference to the soldier settlers who worked small farms after both wars and developed a 'farm or house red' often from mataro which was very hard to sell. Thus we strongly recommend the Blockies and make it our gold medal winner and No 1 choice in this month's Best Value Reds and Whites Und'r \$10.00.

Sometime in the mid 1970's a few winemakers in Margaret River began tinkering with blending the two varieties semillon and sauvignon blanc. It may have been Vasse Felix who first perfected the idea. It did though require the marketing talent and drive of Franklin Tate to bring the attention of this magical blend to a wider drinking public and he did so with this delicious Classic Dry White. Other regions in Australia now copy this blend but it seems the magic of Margaret River does not travel. We believe this wine offers very good drinking value for a readily affordable price.

Some very good and well priced wines are coming out under the Wild Oats label. To make good sauvignon blanc in Australia you need a cool to cold climate. You can head south to Tasmania or go to Margaret River and the deep southern of WA or take the other option which is to head up in elevation. The Wild Oats team looked at both options and for this blend decided to source fruit from the cool regions of WA; these being Margaret River, Pemberton and Frankland River. The result is a cracker and since we have so many from New Zealand for sale, we emphasise that this wine is fuller and riper than those styles and as such gives you a different flavour spectrum. Ah the flavours of wine: it never ceases to surprise us.

A Winemaking Triumph

Light & Finnis Barossa Valley Semillon

This Barossa white is our best discovery for the month. What a sensational wine and what a delight to bring it to you. The Barossa Valley is famed for its rich reds but also has a few other joys to offer, one of which comes off old dry grown semillon vines. It is often said about wine that it's made in the vineyard but this is a broad, sweeping generalisation. Barossa semillon is a variety that needs the hand of a master craftsman back at the winery. The best, and with a large cupboard full of Trophies and Golds for proof, is Christa Binder-Deans at the Veritas winery in the Barossa Valley. Christa took grapes from the Riebbe brother's property in the northern Barossa in the cool of the early morning, extracted about 600 litres from each tonne of grapes, and sent the juice to settle before fermentation. The key is the low extraction rate as this leaves behind all the coarse elements which give white wine a tough taste. The result is beautiful; being bottled in May, 2011 with 500 cases made.

Restless Farm "The Goose" McLaren Vale Shiraz

What a fabulous wine, being another from that most excellent winemaker Nic Bourke. What a wonder he is with this 'down on the farm series'. We have taken stock of all of his creations which have been a Goat, Elephant, Rabbit and now a Goose-all from the strange menagerie of animals he finds at the Restless Farm. He keeps a straight face when he assures us the animals chosen resemble very closely the wine style. We are believers thus we take on trust everything we are told. For the technically minded this shiraz comes from an important vineyard which fronts Seaview Road which cuts across the northern rim of McLaren Vale. Many 'blue chip' wineries such as Coriole, D'Arenberg, and Kays are located here and we refer to this area as the Golden Mile. This shiraz was made in traditional open vat fermenters. The result is very impressive.

Three or four times every decade the winemaking team at Wyndham Estate produce a Bin 444 or Bin 555 that wins numerous Trophies and gold medals. In our view the rest of the vintages are just as good and while they may not be plastered with numerous gold stickers signaling success they represent the safest way to spend your money in a wine store. Both this cabernet and the shiraz are frequently recommended by us for this reason. Here is the winemakers tasting note: "Medium to full bodied in style with ripe blackcurrant and plum Cabernet flavours combined with delicate chocolate /smoky oak. Grape and oak tannins are harmonised to provide a lingering, but soft, structured finish."

Watershed Shades Margaret River Shiraz Merlot Cabernet 2007

Our fondness for the wines of Watershed just grows and grows. Lets tick off those things that will lead to great wine being made; after all why spend your money on wines that cost as much that are not well made? First you grow grapes in the right location and Watershed is just south of the town of Margaret River with nearby 'blue chip' neighbours, Leeuwin Estate, Cape Mentelle and Voyager giving us a tick. Assuming we pick the grapes when perfect and/or the vintage is a good one we get the next tick. In the winery do we have anyone at all who is half competent? Indeed we do in the world class model of Severine Logan who brings a graceful French note to the making of Margaret River wines and after all Margaret River is the closest region Australia has to the famous French region of Bordeaux. This gives us another tick. All that is left is what does this cost. At our Down Under price we rate it very fair value.

A Joy from the Cooler South East of South Australia

Jamiesons Run Limestone Coast Cabernet Shiraz Merlot

This wine offers outstanding value with a good saving. Let us remind ourselves again how wines develop their tastes. One important feature is the location of the vineyards. This Jamiesons Run is sourced from vineyards spread across a large region of south-eastern South Australia, termed the Limestone Coast. This includes the famous region of Coonawarra and newer regions such as Wrattonbully and Robe. All of these regions are affected by weather conditions that blow in from the Southern Ocean hence the grape ripening period is cooler than say another famous region, The Barossa Valley. Thus climate is perfect for cabernet which forms the backbone of this wine. We also reckon the makers are having trouble selling all they make which spells bargain for you. The Jamieson Run is a brilliant medium bodied blend with lovely flavours.

The style has changed markedly and what you will find today is a light vibrant fruit style which is created by including a lot more fruit from cool to cold climate regions. This lightens the flavour load and increases delicacy; both desirable features. It is the most popular of the budget chardonnays in the market so we read this as meaning on average more people like this style than the others. The Jacobs is a friendly face and a case at home for all occasions makes a lot of sense.

The Full Richness of the Barossa

Light and Finnis Barossa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2009

The Light and Finnis wines offer very good value and this is the third or fourth of their Barossa reds we have recommended. They are all small bottlings of individually made or hand crafted wines. As such each is a 'one off' creation but with the wines being from the Barossa Valley they do of course follow a theme as after all Barossa reds are rich and full bodied, no matter who makes them. Cabernet takes second place to shiraz in the Barossa as it is not as consistently successful though the history of cabernet goes back a long way. It is thought that cabernet vines which date back to the 1880s are the oldest in the world. We recall some fabulous Orlando Barossa cabernets of the 1970s and most if not all Barossa wineries release a cabernet these days. This is a very fine wine which gives outstanding value for money.

Goundrey Mount Barker Cabernet Merlot WA

What a gorgeous full, rich, warm inviting mouthful. Many vineyards are now planted along the south western fringe of W.A. They sweep along the coast from Margaret River and go eastwards for hundreds of kilometres. This movement began in the mid to late 1960's and is still steaming ahead. The attraction is simple. The reds are deeply coloured and have warm inviting flavours but they do not get jammy because of the cooling effect of the great Southern Ocean. Goundrey planted a few experimental acres in 1971 and made their first wine in 1976. The rest is history and what is noticeable is a constant improvement in wine quality.



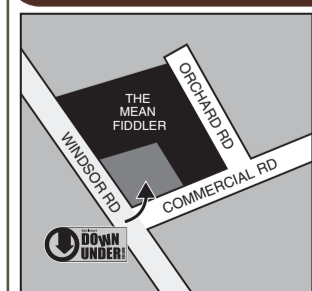
